





Step 1 – Rear Foot Mount

- In the rear of the van, locate the two rear most mounting locations.
- Remove plastic to expose threads in the roof.
- Place the correct large foot assembly (A or B) on top of the rubber pad (10). The drivers side is shown below. The slope on the large foot assembly will be towards the rear of the van.
- The opening in the large foot assembly will open to the outside of the van.
- Mount to exposed threads using a M6 x 20mm hex bolt (4), a M6 lock washer (5) and a M6 flat washer (6).
 - **Be sure to put some E6000 in and around the threads to ensure the roof will not leak in wet applications**
- Do NOT tighten at this point, Allow movement.











Step 2 – Front Foot Mount

- Locate front mount locations as shown prior to Step 1.
- Remove plastic to expose threads in the roof.
- Place small angle bracket (C) as shown. Drivers side is shown in these pictures.
- Offset the bracket to the rear.
- Mount to exposed threads using a M6 x 20mm hex bolt (4), a M6 lock washer (5) and a M6 flat washer (6).

Be sure to put some E6000 in and around the threads to ensure the roof will not leak in wet applications


• Do NOT tighten at this point, Allow movement.







Step 3 – Front Foot

- On previously mounted angle bracket (C), locate the far most rear slot.
- Mount small foot assembly (D) to angle bracket using a 5/16" carriage bolt (1), a 5/16" flat washer (2) and a 5/16" nyloc nut (3).
- The spread between the front foot installed in this step and the foot installed in Step 1 should be 71.5". Do NOT tighten at this point, Allow movement.












<u>Step 4 – Installing Ladder Bows</u>

- Place correct ladder bow on the previously mounted front and rear feet. Be sure to have equal distance along the bow as shown below.
- Bolt in place using 3/8" x .75" hex head (7), a 3/8" lock washer (8) and a 3/8" flat washer (9).
- Follow ladder rack instructions from this point.







ONCE LADDER RACK IS FULLY INSTALLED, BE SURE TO GO BACK AND ENSURE ALL HARDWARE IS TIGHT
